Since 1958:

As research worker and teacher, as first instance judge (special intellectual property division), as counsel for attorneys, in various functions in national and international organizations (e.g. as Vice-President of ALAI, Committee Chairman and member of the Executive Committee of AIPPI, Vice-President and subsequently President of ATRIP, President of the Swedish Copyright Association, Officer of various university associations and institutes and other bodies involved in the field of intellectual property or in related fields).

Outside the university field: studies and advice in civil and commercial law matter, particularly with regard to intellectual property questions, licenses and related matters, business contracts and contracts for technical installations (electronic, engineering, sanitary constructions, etc.) and others, with or without relation to intellectual property rights.

MAJOR PUBLICATIONS

Of a list of 298 printed texts (books, articles, reports, periodicals, etc.), mostly in Swedish (numerous articles have appeared in other languages, in the U.S.A., Germany, France, Norway, the Netherlands, Switzerland and the United Kingdom) concerning intellectual property, four titles amongst those most specialized in intellectual property of a more general nature are given here (Swedish titles translated; title given in the original language):

EXPERIENCE IN COURT LITIGATION

From 1962, served as counsel to attorneys and lawyers who have pleaded before Swedish courts and other courts in countless proceedings;

Appeared before several courts (from the floor) as expert, most recently before the Supreme Court of Sweden in a case of applied art;

The role of the attorney in Sweden is bound with membership of the Swedish bar and it has always appeared essential to him not to mix the roles of teacher and of attorney, preferring a combination of teaching with the tasks of free and independent counsel or of a mediator and arbitrator;

Experience as a State judge (10 months in a special division of the First Instance Court of Stockholm, dealing primarily with patent cases);

Dealt as an expert with matters of the law of sale at the Stockholm Court of Appeal, 1975.

PROFESSIONAL TRAINING IN MEDIATION

Practical experience of his own work, mainly without theoretical studies or institutionalized training.

PROFESSIONAL TRAINING IN ARBITRATION

As with mediation, but constantly follows development of arbitration law in literature and in practice, particularly in specialized seminars.

EXPERIENCE IN MEDIATION

Numerous cases in which he has intervened with solutions based on the confidence of the parties by establishing his own rules, with few formalities applied in terms of formal mediation.

As mediator and counsel in Sweden, Finland and Norway:

- commercial matters, application and interpretation of contracts;
 - licensing of patents, trademarks, copyrights (software, journalists);

EXPERIENCE IN ARBITRATION

Counsel in many cases;

Experience as an arbitrator covers 35 to 40 cases, including three international cases, mostly since 1975. In a small number of cases as sole arbitrator and, with the remainder, on a panel of arbitrators; All activities as an arbitrator have been ad hoc procedures (the reason will be explained below).

The greater number of cases concerned matters of interpretation or application of industrial contracts, contracts for construction enterprises, licensing, investment financing, sales or consortiums (with various elements of intellectual property occasionally playing a more or less important part); acted as arbitrator in a number of cases of assessment concerning the value of shares of limited companies.
