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MADRID PROTOCOL CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL REGISTRATION OF MARKS

Change in the Amounts of the Individual Fee: European Community

- 1. The European Commission has notified to the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) a declaration modifying the amounts of the individual fee payable with respect to the European Community under Article 8(7) of the Madrid Protocol.
- 2. In accordance with Rule 35(2)(b) of the Common Regulations under the Madrid Agreement and Protocol, the Director General has, after consultation with the Office of the European Community (OHIM), established the following new amounts, in Swiss francs, of the said individual fee:

Renewal	for three classes of goods or servicesfor each additional class	1,845 615
	Where the mark is a collective mark: – for three classes of goods or services – for each additional class	4,151 1,230

- 3. The declaration modifying the amounts of the individual fee payable with respect to the European Community will take effect on February 8, 2006.
