MADRID PROTOCOL CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL REGISTRATION OF MARKS

Accession to the Madrid Protocol: Viet Nam

- 1. On April 11, 2006, the Government of Viet Nam deposited with the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) its instrument of accession to the Madrid Protocol Concerning the International Registration of Marks. The Madrid Protocol will enter into force with respect to Viet Nam on July 11, 2006.
- 2. The said instrument of accession was accompanied by the following declaration:
- the declaration referred to in Article 8(7)(a) of the Protocol, whereby Viet Nam wants to receive an individual fee where it is designated in an international application, in a subsequent designation or in respect of the renewal of an international registration (instead of a share in the revenue produced by the supplementary and complementary fees). The amounts in Swiss francs of the said individual fee will be published as soon as they have been established in accordance with Rule 35(2)(b) of the Common Regulations under the Madrid Agreement and Protocol.
- 3. The accession to the Madrid Protocol by Viet Nam brings the number of Contracting Parties of the Protocol to 68. The total number of Contracting Parties of the Madrid system remains 78. A list of the members of the Madrid Union, including the dates on which these Contracting Parties became party to the Agreement and/or the Protocol, is available on the International Marks page on WIPO's website.
