

Madrid Protocol Concerning the International Registration of Marks

Accession to the Madrid Protocol: The Gambia

1. On September 18, 2015, the Government of The Gambia deposited with the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) its instrument of accession to the Protocol Relating to the Madrid Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Marks (“the Madrid Protocol”). The Madrid Protocol will enter into force, with respect to The Gambia, on December 18, 2015.

2. Accession to the Madrid Protocol by The Gambia brings the number of Contracting Parties of the Madrid Protocol to 96.
