

What WIPO does




WIPO provides:

Geographical Diversity






What is Japan Funds-in-Trust?

1. Promoting public awareness campaigns on the importance of the industrial property system


2. Providing assistance to developing countries in establishing/strengthening their industrial property laws and institutions

- **1-year Work plan** (April to March)
- Operated by WIPO in cooperation with Japan
- Result Based Management
 - Set up measurable targets "Performance indicator"
- Performance indicators for this project/workshop are:
- > <u>No. of institutions</u> participating in the project
- <u>% of participants who apply</u> the enhanced knowledge and upgraded skills <u>in their work</u> (70%)
- Solution of participants providing positive feedback on the relevance/usefulness of their work (70%)


