Establishment of a Regional Network of Patent Libraries within schools, colleges and universities to increase access to Global Scientific and Technology Information for Patent Database by the Academe & Industry for Technology Transfer, Research & Development

Objectives

- Increase the access to patent information through a proliferation of patent libraries in schools, colleges & universities
- Create a higher level of awareness among the Management and staff of schools, colleges and universities on the beneficial uses of patent information to their institutions and the local industries
- Organize a regional network of patent libraries to expedite learning and [institutional development through collaborations, work-sharing, and aggregation of resources and exchange of services

Target

At least 20 patent libraries within ASEAN are networked by end of 2015

- SLA with WIPO
- TISC Country Champion in each country to recruit and drive the process of supervising the local network
- Commitment between the Country Champion & local participating universities
- Annual Meetings of Country Champions to share experiences, best practices, concerns, among others
- An e-portal for ASEAN TISC is created where constant communication can be exchanged

Challenges

NATIONAL TISCs

- Strong local support for the project
- Formulation of a Cohesive & Comprehensive
 Training Curriculum to establish standards
- Monitoring National TISCs performance as to compliance with standards
- Promoting and marketing the TISCs
- Keeping the National Network alive

Challenges

REGIONAL TISCs

- Standardized services provided
- Which organization will have authority to supervise the operation of the Regional Network
- Monitoring Performances as a region
- Promoting the services of the network to other regions

Opportunities

- Science & Technology knowledge from patent documents becomes more readily available and accessible to IP stakeholders in the region
- Paves the way to increase the number of proficient patent searchers, drafters & practitioners to serve the community
