#### SUMMARY

This document suggests model wording to serve as a guideline for the applicant in formulating communications to the International Authorities under Chapters I and II of the PCT.

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INTRODUCTION

#### Contents of this Document

- 1. This document contains the first draft of the suggested model wording which is designed to serve as a guideline for the applicant in formulating his communications to the International Authorities under Chapters I and II of the PCT (namely, the Receiving Office, the International Searching and Preliminary Examining Authorities, and the International Bureau) and to the designated and elected Offices.
- 2. The suggested model wording of applicant communications has been first submitted to this Subcommittee since most of them interest the members of this Subcommittee in several capacities: as prospective Receiving Offices as well as prospective International Searching and/or Preliminary Examining Authorities.
- 3. Once the advice of this Subcommittee has been given in respect of the need for and the manner in which means should be established for obtaining uniformity among applicant communications, this advice will be incorporated in any revision of the present document which will be submitted to a subsequent meeting of the PCT Interim Advisory Committee for Administrative Questions.

#### Purpose of this Document

4. As its title indicates, this document contains suggested model wording. Consequently no obligation is intended to be imposed upon the applicant to strictly adhere to the suggested model wording. Its purpose is to serve as a guideline in order to obtain a degree of uniformity among applicant communications.

#### The Approach Taken in this Document

- 5. In the preparation of this document, the International Bureau has, in keeping with the observation contained in paragraph ll(iii) of the Report of the Third Session of the Standing Subcommittee (see document PCT/TCO/SS/III/23), considered the appropriateness of establishing forms to accompany communications sent by the International Authorities to the applicant and upon which the applicant can submit his replies.
- 6. The number of applicant communications which are directly in reply to a communication from an International Authority constitutes only a portion of all applicant communications. Many communications initiated by the applicant are not necessarily in reply to a communication from an International Authority. It appears that to provide forms only for applicant communications which are replies and not to provide means for securing the uniformity of applicant communications in general would attempt to solve only a portion of the problem.
- 7. The great majority of such replies are of the type involving the submission of amendments or corrections. It would be difficult to predetermine what contents this type of reply should have and therefore it would probably in most cases not be possible to design a form which would assist the applicant in formulating his reply by providing for the mere checking of a box or the insertion of a few words. It thus appears that applicant reply forms would, other than possibly containing instructions governing the submission of the necessary amendments or corrections (such instructions are, however, already contained in the form communicated by the International Authority to which the reply form is suggested to be accompanied), normally be mere blank pages.
- 8. Consequently, the International Bureau in preparing this document has, in light of the considerations set forth in the preceding paragraphs, taken the approach of establishing suggested model wording to cover all applicant communications.

#### The Manner of Construction of Applicant Communications

9. It is recommended that the following example of the construction of any particular applicant communication should serve as a guideline.

Items 1. to 3. in the above example illustrate the three basic components: the Identification, the Suggested Model Wording, and the Signature, of an applicant communication.

- 10. The Identification (item 1., above) embodies the indication of the date of mailing of applicant's communication, the indication of the reference number (where applicable) of the communication issued by the International Authority to which applicant's communication is in reply, and the indications relating to the identification of the international application. The question whether and in what manner the name of the applicant is to be used for identification purposes (particularly, where there are several applicants) is to be regulated by the Administrative Instructions. Where an applicant's communication relates to a purported international application, i.e. an application which has not yet been accorded an international filing date, the indication should contain the Identification of Purported International Application, and include indications of the Applicant, Application No., and Date of Receipt of the application by the receiving Office.
- ll. The Suggested Model Wording (item 2., above) embodies the indication of the title which identifies the nature of the communication and the citation of the relevant provision of the PCT to which said communication relates, the indication of the addressees, and the substance of the communication. Where a particular communication has various possible addressees, the International Authorities or designated or elected Offices to which the communication may be addressed, are set forth. Where a particular communication is applicable both under Chapters I and II of the PCT, the citations to the relevant Chapter I and Chapter II provisions are indicated. In respect of the communications applicable both under Chapters I and II, the parts (i.e., citation, addressees, substance of the communication) applicable to Chapter II are set off in /square brackets/.
- 12. Inclusion of the Signature (item 3., above) is based upon Rule 92.1 which provides that the communication is required to be signed by the applicant. However, Rule 92.1 should be read in view of Rule 2.1 which indicates that the signature may be that of the agent or other representative unless the contrary clearly follows from the wording or the nature of the provision or the context in which the word is used.
- 13. For the applicant communications listed in this document, only the Suggested Model Wording is reproduced thereunder since the other basic components are essentially the same for all applicant communications.
- 14. The contents of the Suggested Model Wording follows the usual practice that, wherever appropriate, a word used in the singular stands also for the plural.
  - 15. The Standing Subcommittee is invited to examine and comment on the draft suggested model wordings contained in this document.
