

# Summary of Assets and Liabilities December 31, 2014




Overall Reserves (Net assets) of the Organization are 245.8 million Swiss francs, up from 208.8 million Swiss francs at the end of 2013.

  - PCT Fees Hedging




## Trend in PCT Filings






## Share of PCT Filings





## PCT Filings by Origin – top origins








#### Trend in Madrid Filings





## Madrid Filings by Origin – top origins









## Trend in Hague Filings (designs)






# Hague Filings by Origin – top origins (designs)





#### WIPO Domain Name Dispute Resolution



- 15 years WIPO UDRP: 30,000+ cases re 58,000+ names
- 2014: 2,634 cases(+2%), 5,591 domain names
  - Parties from 108 countries, 297 panelists, 16 languages of proceedings
- 500 new gTLDs, out of 1,400 ICANN-approved gTLDs (including some 100 using internationalized scripts)
- 72 ccTLDs designating WIPO dispute service




The **W**orld **I**ntellectual **P**roperty **O**rganization Re:Search consortium:

Global initiative established to encourage and facilitate the sharing of intellectual property assets to advance **drug**, **vaccine**, and **diagnostic** development for **malaria**, **tuberculosis**, and **neglected tropical diseases** (NTDs)






#### WIPO Re:Search Collaborations

Drugs remain the top product by number of collaborations.

Collaborations are shifting from academic + industry → academic + academic partnerships.

#### Accessible Books Consortium

Consortium between publishers and authors, libraries, blind organizations

#### Functions

- International (Accessible Format) Book Exchange
  - 16,000 loans of books in accessible formats to individuals
  - 2,540 files downloaded by Authorized Entities (AEs), resulting in savings to AEs of approximately CHF 5.1 million
- Inclusive Publishing
  - Signature of the ABC Charter for Accessible Publishing by twelve publishers
- Capacity Building
  - Establishment of capacity building projects in Bangladesh, India, Nepal and Sri Lanka

- Annual Reports on PCT, Madrid and the Hague Systems
  - Published each April for preceding year
- Global Innovation Index
  - Published each year in cooperation with INSEAD and Cornell University

CTUAL PROPERTY

- Provides benchmarks for innovation capacity and best practices
- World Intellectual Property Report
  - Published every two years on specific themes
  - 2011: The Changing Face of Innovation
  - 2013: Brands: Reputation and Image in the Global Marketplace
  - 2015: "Economic Growth and Breakthrough Innovations"
