The Parties agree that the United States District Court for the Western District of Washington shall have exclusive jurisdiction over them for all purposes relating to the implementation and effectuation of this Order and all provisions thereof. Any and all disputes, requests or petitions regarding or arising out of the enforcement, construction, administration or interpretation of this Order must be made, if at all, to that Court by means of commencing an action seeking enforcement of the terms of this Stipulation.
- 5. Having obtained the express permission and consent of their respective clients, the undersigned signatories represent that they are fully authorized to execute and enter into the terms and conditions of this Order on behalf of the respective persons or entities for whom they have signed it.
