

- Nonprofit organization
- Under the authorization and direction of the Ministry of information industry
- Within Computer Network Information Center, CAS
- CNNIC Steering Committee supervises and evaluates the construction, operation and performance of CNNIC.









- **Registration Service:** domain names registration, IP addresses distribution, autonomous system codes
- Directory services: Whois
- Information Service: Semiannual Survey Report on the Development of China's Internet, CNNIC's Third Party Web Site Traffic Audit
- International Coordination
- Research and Development

### Domain Names of China's Internet

- Category Domain Names (6)
   COM.CN: enterprises EDU: educational institutions
   NET.CN: information centers and operation centers of interconnecting and accessing networks
   ORG.CN: non-profit organizations.
   GOV.CN: government agencies
   AC.CN: scientific research institutions
- Administrative Division Domain Names (34) e.g. BJ.CN :Beijing Municipality

#### **Pre-registration Measures**

- for well-known trademarks
- for well-known trade names or business names
- for important administrative district names
- for names of governmental organs









#### **Domain Name Registration Agreement**

- Domain Name Registrants' Contact Details
- Domain Name Registrants' Representations









# Domain Name Registrants' Contact Details

- The name of the authorized person for administrative or technical contact purpose
- The applicant's full name, post address telephone, fax and email









## Domain Name Registrants' Representations

- No infringement against the legitimate rights or interests of any third party
- Truthfulness and accuracy of the contact information
- Commitment to submit to the jurisdiction of China People's Court and the administrative dispute resolution procedure enacted by CNNIC

## Registrar's Examination After Registration

- Based on the agreement between CNNIC and registrars
- To the best knowledge of the registrar, to prevent the domain name registration from being contradictory to the interests of the state, society or the public within individual knowledge range
- Registrar's disclaimer



### Alternative Dispute Resolution System

- "Chinese Domain Name Dispute Resolution Policy" November 1, 2000
- Domain Name Dispute Settlement Center of China International Economic and Trade Arbitration Commission, Jan. 1, 2001.









### **Requirements for Complaints**

- The complained domain name is identical with or confusingly similar to the complainant's trademark;
- The domain name registrant does not have trademark right, or any other legitimate right or interest;
- The domain name registrant is in bad faith;
- The domain name has adverse affects to complainant's business

#### Evidence of Bad Faith

- Offering to sell the domain name for profit;
- Attempting to prevent the owner of the trademark from reflecting the mark in a corresponding domain name;
- The domain name registrant attempts to attract, for financial gain, internet users to the domain name registrant's website or other on-line location, by creating confusion with the trademark of the complainant.

### Domain Name Registrants' Defenses

- Having a legally protected right or interest;
- Having commenced legitimate use of the domain name, and consequently gained considerable reputation;
- Causing no negative effect on the registered trademark or the trademark owner;
- The complainant had registered a completely different domain name, without convincing evidence that he had legitimate reasons for not registering the domain name at the outset;
- The trademark for which protection is requested had not yet protected in china.





- The complaints are in both electronic and tangible form.
- The respondent may file the defenses in 20 days.
- Combination of procedures
- Untouched judiciary, arbitration or meditation resolution
- The decision shall be made within 14 days by the expert panel.
