






CUSTOMS BRANCH ON THE EU EXTERNAL BORDER





Customs' responsibilities




Control of goods crossing a border, for purposes such as:

- Collecting customs duty,
- Security, safety and public health requirements,

... including intellectual property rights



* Checks of compliance with provisions of customs law and with other provisions on import of goods into and export from the EU






* calculation and collection of customs duties and other charges connected with import and export of goods.



calculation and collection of VAT on import of goods into the EU



* cooperation in implementation of the EU Common Agricultural Policy.







*identification, prevention and detection of fiscal crimes and offences, crimes and offences connected to import and export of goods and tracing the offenders thereof, as required by other legal acts





 identification and fight against crimes and offences related to violation of the EU regulations on protection of national treasure







fight against crimes and offences connected with placing in, and removing from the Polish customs territory of goods covered by restrictions or prohibitions, such as: harmful waste, chemical substances, nuclear and radioactive materials, narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances, as well weapons, ammunition, as explosives and technologies subject to international control.



Responsibilities Intellectual Property Rights Division

- coordination of co-operation with right holders in enforcement in the IPR area
- analysis of international, EU and national legislation regarding IPR
- supervision of customs procedures
- IT system Leonardo da VINCI (VINCI)
- co-operation with government administration and with NGO-s liable for protection of IPR



The EU Applicable law

Council Regulation (EC) No 1383/2003

of 22 July 2003 concerning customs action against goods suspected of infringing certain intellectual property rights and the measures to be taken against goods found to have infringed such rights

Commission Regulation (EC) No 1891/2004

of 21 October 2004 laying down provisions for the implementation of Council Regulation (EC) No. 1383/2003



Council Regulation (EC) No 1383/2003

Customs protection:

- on application
- ex-officio
- simplifield procedure



Office responsible for collecting the applications in IPR customs protection area

Customs Chamber in Warsaw

- Collection and approval of national applications
- Collection and approval of Community applications



Customs Chamber in Warsaw



- Approval of application issuing the decision
- Entering of the decision into the VINCI system
- Sending decisions to all of the customs chambers



Aplication for action by polish customs authorites

- Applications are lodge to Customs Chamber in Warsaw
- Filling the community forms following the regulations 1383/2003 and 1894/2004










Number of registered cases 2008-2010






Quantity of goods deteined in 2008 by Polish Customs Services divided on categories




