Biographical Note

A Member of the Quebec Bar, Mr. Bisson is Head, International Registration Systems Legal Service, at the World Intellectual Property Organization (<http://www.wipo.int>). His previous positions with WIPO included overseeing the examination and registration activities under the Madrid system for the international registration of marks and the Hague Agreement for the international registration of industrial designs. He joined WIPO in 1995 after a short stint with the Canadian Trade-Mark Opposition Board. Before that, he was Senior Legal Advisor with the Canadian Federal Government, handling intellectual property policy matters and oversaw in particular the TRIPS implementing legislation. At the same time, he was lecturing on the legal aspects of transfer of technology at the University of Ottawa.
