Madam, Sir,

Following consultation under Rule 89.2(b) of the Regulations under the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) with interested Offices and Authorities, the Administrative Instructions under the PCT and Parts I, II and III of Annex A to the Administrative Instructions under the PCT are modified with effect from January 1, 2003. The modifications are as proposed by Circulars C.PCT 880 (dated November 6, 2002) and C.PCT 882 (dated November 20, 2002), except where further changes have been made as a result of consultations, as indicated below (editorial and minor drafting changes are not mentioned).

Modified text of the Administrative Instructions under the PCT

In addition to the changes proposed by Circulars C.PCT 880 and 882, modifications have been made to Section 405.
