National laws and rules dealing with cross-border aspects of confidentiality of communications between clients and patent advisors;

No provision on the Cyprus National Law concerning confidentiality.

- Problems in relation to cross-border aspects of confidentiality of communications between clients and patent advisors;

Not applicable for the abovementioned reasons. Also please note that the Cyprus Office undertake no substantive examination on patents, only formalities check.

- Remedies that are available in countries and regions to solve the problems that remain at the national, bilateral, plurilateral and regional levels:

Article 60 and 61 of the National Law, provide for a cause of action in case of an infringement of a patent right, or in case of an application of a patent right. Article 60 provides for action for infringement, which may include either an order for stopping the infringement, including an interim order or an order for damages and/or destruction/forfeiture of the infringed goods.
