## <u>UKRAINE</u>

Referring to the WIPO Circular 8585 dated August 16, 2016 regarding the request for information needed for the 25-th session of the Standing Committee on the Law of Patents (SCP), on behalf of Acting Chairperson of the State Intellectual Property Service of Ukraine Ms. Antonina Malysh, I would like to provide the requested information step by step following each question raised in the said Circular.
