The DIP has no further information on this matter. The Regulatory approval is authorized by the Food and Drug Administration which will not include the consideration of patent registration information. This exclusion will be used as a defense of the defendant in the case of alleged patent infringement.

(b) input with respect to the constraints faced by developing countries and least developed countries (LDCs) in making full use of patent flexibilities and their impacts on the access to affordable especially essential medicines for public health purposes in those countries.
