FORMAT (MARGINS, SIZE) OF PATENT DOCUMENTS

SIZE OF PATENT DOCUMENTS

- 1. A standard size of patent documents is recommended for the following reasons:
 - (i) stacking in examiners' search files;
 - (ii) shelving in libraries;
 - (iii) uniformity in binding;
 - (iv) facilitating reproduction, e.g., microfilming, photocopying, scanning, etc.
- 2. The size of the pages of patent documents should be A4, this being 297 mm by 210 mm (approximately 11-% inches by 8-¼ inches).
- 3. If the A4 size cannot be accepted, it is recommended that the pages should not exceed this A4 size in either dimension.

MARGINS OF PATENT DOCUMENTS

- 4. The guidelines below apply only to the minimum size of margins of patent documents. Maximum size of margins is not considered here.
- 5. The minimum size of margins recommended below apply irrespective of the size of the pages of the patent documents concerned.
- 6. It is recommended to provide for uniform margins in patent documents with the following minimum dimensions:

Upper margin of each page, except the first page:	20 mm
Upper margin of the first page:	30 mm
Side margin of the first page:	25 mm
Other side margin:	20 mm
Bottom margin:	20 mm
