THE PROCEDURE IN THE NATIONAL PHASE

- BB.01 **TRANSLATION (CORRECTION).** Errors in the translation of the international application can be corrected with reference to the text of the international application as filed (see paragraphs 57 and 58 of the General Part of this Volume).

30(2) BB.03 **DESIGNATION OF THE INVENTOR.** For details, see the model in Annex BB.II. Legalization is not required. For time limits, see the Summary.

If, upon review under PCT Article 25, the Office denies an error or omission on the part of the receiving Office or the International Bureau, an appeal against this decision may be lodged to the High Court by a notice of motion within 30 days from the date of receipt of the decision.

PR Rule 44 BB.09 **EXCUSE OF DELAYS IN MEETING TIME LIMITS.** Where the applicant failed to comply with a time limit during the international phase or before the Office, he may request extension of time. Such request must be addressed to the Office together with an affidavit setting forth the relevant facts and is subject to the payment of a special fee (see Annex BB.I). Extension of time may be requested either before or after the expiration of the time. The extension may be granted by the Office for such period as the Office thinks suitable in the circumstances of the case.
