

ADMINISTRATIVE PANEL DECISION

ECO Trading Goods S.R.L. v. Alen Vuk, WEULTIMATE, SPLETNA TRGOVINA, D.O.O.

Case No. D2026-3404

1. The Parties

The Complainant is ECO Trading Goods S.R.L., Romania, represented by IP Boutique – Cabinet P.I., Romania.

The Respondent is Alen Vuk, WEULTIMATE, SPLETNA TRGOVINA, D.O.O., Slovenia.

2. The Domain Name and Registrar

The disputed domain name <ecolinos.com> is registered with Gransy, s.r.o. d/b/a subreg.cz (the “Registrar”).

3. Procedural History

The Complaint was filed with the WIPO Arbitration and Mediation Center (the “Center”) on July 31, 2026. On August 4, 2026, the Center transmitted by email to the Registrar a request for registrar verification in connection with the disputed domain name. On August 5, 2026, the Registrar transmitted by email to the Center its verification response confirming that the Respondent is listed as the registrant and providing the contact details.

The Center verified that the Complaint satisfied the formal requirements of the Uniform Domain Name Dispute Resolution Policy (the “Policy” or “UDRP”), the Rules for Uniform Domain Name Dispute Resolution Policy (the “Rules”), and the WIPO Supplemental Rules for Uniform Domain Name Dispute Resolution Policy (the “Supplemental Rules”).

In accordance with the Rules, paragraphs 2 and 4, the Center formally notified the Respondent of the Complaint, and the proceeding commenced on August 12, 2026. In accordance with the Rules, paragraph 5, the due date for Response was September 1, 2026. The Respondent sent an email communication to the Center on August 28, 2026, confirming his consent to the transfer the disputed domain name to the Complainant. The Center sent a possible settlement email to the Parties on September 1, 2026. On September 2, 2026, the Complainant requested the Center to continue with the current proceeding. The Center notified the Parties of the commencement of Panel appointment process on the same day.

The Center appointed Sebastian M.W. Hughes as the sole panelist in this matter on September 10, 2026. The Panel finds that it was properly constituted. The Panel has submitted the Statement of Acceptance and Declaration of Impartiality and Independence, as required by the Center to ensure compliance with the Rules, paragraph 7.

4. Consent to Transfer

On August 28, 2026, the Respondent sent an email to the Center attaching the Center's Standard Settlement Form signed by the Respondent, and confirming his consent to the transfer of the disputed domain name to the Complainant.

The Complainant has also, in its email to the Center dated September 2, 2026, requested the Panel to make an order herein for the transfer of the disputed domain name to the Complainant by consent.

The Panel considers, in the circumstances, it is appropriate to order transfer of the disputed domain name solely on the basis of such consent (see WIPO Overview of WIPO Panel Views on Select UDRP Questions (["WIPO Overview 3.1"](#)), section 4.10).

5. Decision

For the foregoing reasons, in accordance with paragraphs 4(i) of the Policy and 15 of the Rules, the Panel orders that the disputed domain name <ecolinos.com> be transferred to the Complainant.
