

## **Madrid Protocol Concerning the International Registration of Marks**

### **Change in the Amounts of the Individual Fee: Zambia**

1. In accordance with Rule 35(2)(d) of the Common Regulations under the Madrid Agreement and Protocol, the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) has established the following new amounts, in Swiss francs, of the individual fee that is payable when Zambia is designated in an international application, in a designation subsequent to an international registration and in respect of the renewal of an international registration in which Zambia has been designated:

<b>ITEMS</b>		<b>Amounts</b> <i>(in Swiss francs)</i>
Application or Subsequent Designation	– for one class of goods or services	125
	– for each additional class	100
Renewal	– for one class of goods or services	416
	– for each additional class	332

2. This change shall have effect on March 28, 2019. Therefore, these amounts will be payable where Zambia

(a) is designated in an international application which is received by the Office of origin on or after that date; or

(b) is the subject of a subsequent designation which is received by the Office of the Contracting Party of the holder on or after that date, or is filed directly with the International Bureau of WIPO on or after that date; or

(c) has been designated in an international registration which is renewed on or after that date.
