

Madrid Protocol Concerning the International Registration of Marks

Change in the Amounts of the Individual Fee: Tunisia

1. In accordance with Rule 35(2)(d) of the Regulations under the Madrid Protocol, the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) has established new amounts, in Swiss francs, of the individual fee that is payable when Tunisia is designated in an international application, in a designation subsequent to an international registration and in respect of the renewal of an international registration in which Tunisia has been designated.
2. As from December 18, 2022, the amounts of the individual fee payable in respect of Tunisia will be the following:

3. These new amounts will be payable where Tunisia
 - (a) is designated in an international application which is received by the Office of origin on or after December 18, 2022; or

(b) is the subject of a subsequent designation which is received by the Office of the Contracting Party of the holder on or after December 18, 2022, or is filed directly with the International Bureau of WIPO on or after that date; or

(c) has been designated in an international registration which is renewed on or after December 18, 2022.
