Madrid Protocol Concerning the International Registration of Marks

Change in the Amounts of the Individual Fee: Canada

- 1. The Government of Canada has notified to the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) a declaration modifying the amounts of the individual fee payable with respect to Canada under Article 8(7) of the Madrid Protocol.
- 2. As from January 1, 2024, the amounts of the individual fee payable in respect of Canada will be the following:

Application or Subsequent Designation	for one class of goods or services for each additional class	255 77	299 91
Renewal	for one class of goods or services for each additional class	309 96	362 113

- 3. These new amounts will be payable where Canada
- (a) is designated in an international application which is received by the Office of origin on or after January 1, 2024; or
- (b) is the subject of a subsequent designation which is received by the Office of the Contracting Party of the holder or is filed directly with the International Bureau of WIPO on or after that date; or
- (c) has been designated in an international registration which is renewed on or after that date.
