PROTOCOL RELATING TO THE MADRID AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL REGISTRATION OF MARKS

Accession by Georgia

1. On May 20, 1998, Georgia deposited with the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) its instrument of accession to the Protocol Relating to the Madrid Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Marks, adopted at Madrid on June 27, 1989. The Madrid Protocol will enter into force, with respect to Georgia, on August 20, 1998.

2. Accession by Georgia to the Madrid Protocol brings the number of the Contracting Parties of the Protocol to 31, namely, Belgium, China, Cuba, Czech Republic, Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Denmark, Finland, France, Georgia, Germany, Hungary, Iceland, Kenya, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Monaco, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Republic of Moldova, Romania, Russian Federation, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, United Kingdom and Yugoslavia.
