## MADRID AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL REGISTRATION OF MARKS AND PROTOCOL RELATING TO THAT AGREEMENT

## Accession by the Republic of Mozambique

- 1. On July 7, 1998, the Republic of Mozambique deposited with the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) its instruments of accession to the Madrid Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Marks of April 14, 1891, as revised at Stockholm on July 14, 1967, and amended on September 28, 1979 ("the Madrid Agreement") and to the Protocol Relating to the Madrid Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Marks ("the Madrid Protocol"), adopted at Madrid on June 27, 1989.
- 2. The instrument of accession to the Madrid Agreement contained the following declaration:
- under Article 3bis(1) of the Madrid Agreement, protection resulting from an international registration shall extend to the Republic of Mozambique only at the express request of the proprietor of the mark.
- 3. The Madrid Agreement and the Madrid Protocol will enter into force, with respect to the Republic of Mozambique, on October 7, 1998. This will bring the number of members of the Madrid Union to 57 (25 party to the Madrid Agreement only, eight party to the Protocol only and 24 party to both the Agreement and the Protocol).
