MADRID AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL REGISTRATION OF MARKS AND PROTOCOL RELATING TO THAT AGREEMENT

Accession by the Kingdom of Swaziland

- 1. On September 14, 1998, the Kingdom of Swaziland deposited with the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) its instruments of accession to the Madrid Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Marks of April 14, 1891, as revised at Stockholm on July 14, 1967, and amended on September 28, 1979 ("the Madrid Agreement") and to the Protocol Relating to the Madrid Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Marks ("the Madrid Protocol"), adopted at Madrid on June 27, 1989.
- 2. The Madrid Agreement and the Madrid Protocol will enter into force, with respect to the Kingdom of Swaziland, on December 14, 1998. This will bring the number of members of the Madrid Union to 59 (25 party to the Madrid Agreement only, nine party to the Protocol only and 25 party to both the Agreement and the Protocol).
