## $\label{eq:commonRegulations} Declaration Made Under Rule 20 \quad \textit{bis} (6) (b) of the Common Regulations \\ \quad under the Madrid Agreement and Proto \quad col: Greece$

- 1. In a notification addressed to the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization, Greece has made the declaration provided for by Rule 20bis(6)(b) of the Common Regulations under the Madrid Agreement, in accord ance with which the recording of licences in the International Register has no effect in that country.
- 2. Itfollowsthataholderorlicenseeshouldbeawarethat,asfarasGreeceisconcerned,it servesnopurposetorequesttherecordingin theInternationalRegisterofalicencerelatingto aninternationalregistrationofmark(suchrecordingcarryingnolegaleffectinthatcountryas a result of the said declaration). Consequently, the formalities required for the recording in Greece of a licence relating to an international registration of mark must continue to be completed directly with the Greek Office and according to the conditions laid down by the legislationofthatcountry.
