## PROTOCOLRELATINGTOTHEMADRIDAGREEMENTCONCERNING THEINTERNATIONALREGISTRATIONOFMARKS

## AccessionbytheRepublicofMacedonia

1. On May 30, 2002, the Government of the Republic of Macedo nia deposited with the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) its instrument of accession to the Protocol Relating to the Madrid Agreement Concerning the International RegistrationofMarks. The MadridProtocolwillenter intoforce with respect to the Republic of Macedonia on August 30, 2002.

2. Accession to the Madrid Protocol by the Republic of Macedonia brings the number of Contracting Parties of the Protocol to 56, namely, Antigua and Barbuda, Armenia, Australia, Austra, Belarus, Belgium, Bhutan, Bulgaria, China, Cuba, Czech Republic, Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Georgia, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Kenya, Latvia, Lesotho, Liechtenste in, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Monaco, Mongolia, Morocco, Mozambique, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Republic of Macedonia, Republicof Moldova, Romania, Russian Federation, Sierra Leone, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Swaziland, Sweden, Switzer land, Turkey, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, United Kingdom, YugoslaviaandZambia.
