

Madrid Protocol Concerning the International Registration of Marks

Individual Fee under Article 8(7): India

1. The Government of India has made the declaration referred to in Article 8(7) of the Protocol whereby it wants to receive an individual fee when India is designated, either in an international application or in a designation subsequent to an international registration or in respect of the renewal of an international registration designating India (instead of a share in the revenue produced by the supplementary and complementary fees).

2. In accordance with Rule 35(2)(b) of the Common Regulations under the Madrid Agreement and Protocol, the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) has, after consultation with the Office of India, established the following amounts in Swiss francs of the said individual fee:

3. The declaration concerning the individual fee made by India will enter into force on July 8, 2013.
