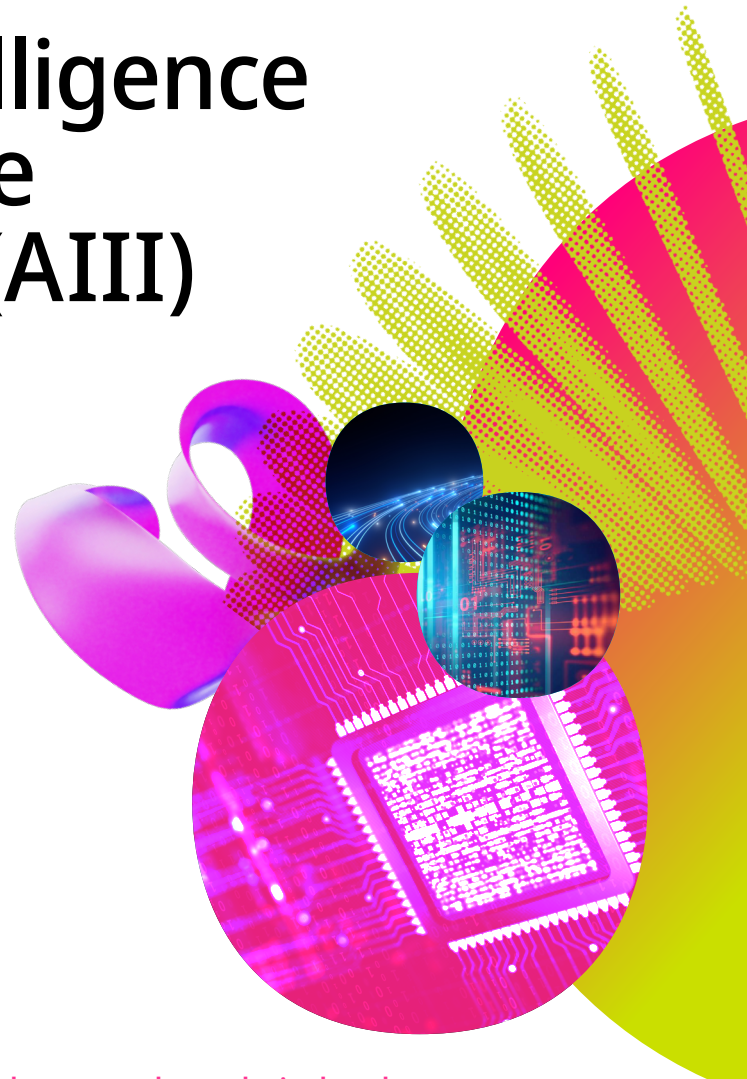




# Artificial Intelligence Infrastructure Interchange (AIII)

## **About the Artificial Intelligence Infrastructure Interchange (AIII)**

Launched on March 17, 2026, the AI Infrastructure Interchange (AIII) focuses on the technical and operational dimensions of IP in the context of AI. It is a neutral, collaborative space for technical experts to explore how infrastructure (such as metadata, watermarking, identifiers and rights management systems) can respond to the challenges and opportunities created by AI. Updates on the ongoing work of AIII will be presented at an Annual Meeting.

AIII does not set policy or legal standards. Instead, it focuses on how technical systems and tools can effectively support creators, copyright owners, and innovators while also promoting the development of AI technology in a rapidly evolving environment.

### What kind of questions is AIII exploring?

While these may evolve over time, discussions could include:

- Practical and technical considerations such as approaches to identifying and managing AI-generated outputs, identifying human and AI contributions to works or innovations; and
- The potential role of technical tools, such as watermarking, in supporting the implementation of policy decisions.

### What does AIII look like?

To support the detailed, technical-level discussions envisioned for AIII, the initiative has established a Technical Exchange Network, comprising technical experts from the private sector – such as tech companies, AI developers, rightsholders, individual creators – academia, and civil society.

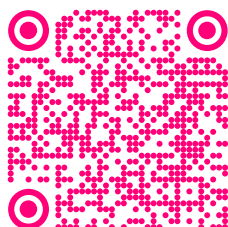
