At its fifth session, held from November 8 to 11, 2004, the Standards and Documentation Working Group (SDWG) of the Standing Committee on Information Technologies (SCIT) agreed to create the above-mentioned Task Force for the activities as described in document SCIT/SDWG/5/12 (see paragraphs 103 to 105 of document SCIT/SDWG/5/13).
