Dear Madam/Sir,

At its sixth session, held from September 19 to 22, 2005, the Standards and Documentation Working Group (SDWG) of the Standing Committee on Information Technologies (SCIT) agreed to:

- (a) leave current Task No. 24 and ATRs as they are for the time being without any modification; and
- (b) create a new Task Force which should clarify the objectives of the ATRs and the target users (including industrial property information providers and users). Once this has been achieved the Task Force should prepare a proposal to revise and update the current recommended contents of the ATRs.

Current Task No. 24 reads as follows:

"Collect and publish Annual Technical Reports (ATRs) on Patent, Trademark and Industrial Design Information Activities of the SCIT Members (ATR/PI, ATR/TM, ATR/ID)".
