

## Hague Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Industrial Designs

### Change in the amounts of the individual designation fee: Turkmenistan

1. In accordance with Rule 28(2)(d) of the Regulations Under the Geneva Act (1999) of the Hague Agreement, the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) has established the following new amounts, in Swiss francs, of the individual designation fee which must be paid in connection with an international application in which Turkmenistan is designated, and in connection with the renewal of an international registration designating Turkmenistan:

First Renewal	— for each design	1,019	897
