

Hague Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Industrial Designs

Individual Designation Fee: Uzbekistan

1. On October 10, 2024, the Government of Uzbekistan deposited with the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) its instrument of accession to the Geneva Act of the Hague Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Industrial Designs (“Geneva Act”).

2. The instrument of accession was accompanied by the declaration referred to in Article 7(2) of the Geneva Act, whereby, in connection with an international application in which Uzbekistan is designated, and in connection with the renewal of an international registration designating Uzbekistan, the prescribed designation fee shall be replaced by an individual designation fee (refer to [Information Notice No 16/2024](#)). On April 30, 2025, the Government of Uzbekistan notified the International Bureau of the amounts of the individual designation fee.

3. In accordance with Rule 28(2)(b) of the Regulations Under the Geneva Act (1999) of the Hague Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Industrial Designs (“Regulations”), the Director General of WIPO has established, after consultation with the Office of Uzbekistan, the amounts of the individual designation fee payable in connection with an international application in which Uzbekistan is designated and in connection with the renewal of an international registration designating Uzbekistan, as follows:

Individual Designation Fee		Amounts (in Swiss francs)
International Application	– for the first design	262
	– for each additional design*	43
Renewal	– first renewal	284
	– second renewal	437

* Uzbekistan has made a declaration under Article 13(1) of the Geneva Act whereby, in accordance with its law, an application may only contain one independent and distinct industrial design, or one design and its variants differing from that design by visually insignificant features and/or by color combination, or a group of industrial designs belonging to the same set of products as well as one or more industrial designs for separate products belonging to the same set of products.

4. In accordance with Article 30(1)(ii) of the Geneva Act, the above declaration relating to the individual designation fee will enter into force on July 30, 2025. In this regard, it should be noted that the individual designation fee will be payable where Uzbekistan is designated in an international application whose international registration date is on or after the above date, in light of Article 10(2) of the Geneva Act.
