

Hague Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Industrial Designs

Individual Designation Fee: Eurasian Patent Organization (EAPO)

1. On July 10, 2026, the Eurasian Patent Organization (EAPO) deposited with the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) its instrument of accession to the Geneva Act of the Hague Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Industrial Designs ("Geneva Act").

2. The instrument of accession was accompanied by the declaration referred to in Article 7(2) of the Geneva Act, whereby, in connection with an international application in which EAPO is designated, and in connection with the renewal of an international registration designating EAPO, the prescribed designation fee shall be replaced by an individual designation fee (refer to [Information Notice No 7/2026](#)).

3. In accordance with Rule 28(2)(b) of the Regulations Under the Geneva Act (1999) of the Hague Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Industrial Designs ("Regulations"), the Director General of WIPO has established, after consultation with EAPO, the amounts of the individual designation fee payable in connection with an international application in which EAPO is designated and in connection with the renewal of an international registration designating EAPO, as follows:

5. In accordance with Article 30(1)(i) of the Geneva Act, the above declaration relating to the individual designation fee will enter into force on October 10, 2026. In this regard, it should be noted that the individual designation fee will be payable where EAPO is designated in an international application whose international registration date is on or after the above date, in light of Article 10(2) of the Geneva Act.
