

Hague Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Industrial Designs

Change in the amounts of the individual designation fee: Republic of Korea

1. In accordance with Rule 28(2)(d) of the Regulations Under the Geneva Act (1999) of the Hague Agreement, the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) has established the following new amounts, in Swiss francs, of the individual designation fee* which must be paid in connection with an international application in which the Republic of Korea is designated, and in connection with the renewal of an international registration designating the Republic of Korea:

International Application	– for each design	143	125
First Renewal	– for each design	230	201
Second Renewal	– for each design	544	475
Third Renewal	– for each design	628	548

2. This change will take effect on September 1, 2026.

* Whether the individual designation fee (instead of level 3 of the standard designation fee) is applied for an international application and renewal of an international registration, in which the Republic of Korea is designated, is determined by the relevant class of the International Classification for Industrial Designs (Locarno Classification) and the international registration date (see [Information Notice No. 35/2020](#)).
