

Scope of protection

Art 5 TK – Art 5 TCEs

- Seeks to determine
 - Which specific acts in respect of TK and TCEs should be prohibited/prevented
 - What specific rights should be granted to the beneficiaries of protection

Scope of protection

Art 5 TK – Art 5 TCEs

- Different approaches and options present in both texts
 - «Rights-based» and/or «measures-based»
 - «Right to say no» and «right to be compensated»
 - «Economic» and «moral» types of rights
 - Tiered or differentiated approach
 - Approaches not necessarily mutually exclusive

The tiered or differentiated approach

Different kinds or levels of rights or measures would be available to rights holders depending on the nature and characteristics of the subject matter, the level of control retained by the beneficiaries and its degree of diffusion.

The tiered approach:

- Is a tiered approach feasible?
- Appropriate determination of the tiers

The tiered or differentiated approach

(examples based on WIPO/GRTKF/IC/40/4 and WIPO/GRTKF/IC/40/5)

- TK context: opportunity to respond to the reality of the differences amongst:
 - Secret TK
 - Narrowly diffused TK
 - Widely diffused TK
- TCEs context:
 - TCEs of particular spiritual or cultural value or significance
 - Other TCEs
- Consideration of the practicality and legal implications of the tiers

Scope of protection

- Level of detail of the provisions
- Lower level – more flexibility for States to determine the scope through domestic implementing legislation and measures
- Higher level – ensures maximum harmonization

Exceptions and limitations

Art 9 TK – Art 7 TCEs

- Alternatives follow two approaches:
 - Leave flexibility at the national level to fully regulate exceptions and limitations
 - Provide general and/or specific exceptions

Exceptions and limitations

Art 9 TK – Art 7 TCEs

■ General exceptions

- Test to be applied at the national level when developing limitations and exceptions
- Could include elements of the “classic” three-step test and moral-right components

■ Specific exceptions

- Kinds of exceptions that should be included/allowed

Exceptions and limitations

- Tiered approach to exceptions?
- Various degrees of excepted acts mirror various kinds of subject matter and the tiered rights applied to them

Objectives

- Fundamental to development of operative text
- Consider perspectives of all interested parties (rightsholders, users, public)
- IP-related and relevant policy objectives
- The issue of the public domain
