

## MADRID PROTOCOL

### *NOTE FOR FILING*

#### MODEL FORM 13 (MF13): DECLARATION THAT A LIMITATION HAS NO EFFECT

Rule 27(5) of the Regulations

---

Use this form when the International Bureau has notified the Office of a limitation of the list of goods and services under Rule 25 and the Office wishes to declare that this limitation has no effect in its territory.

The declaration must be sent to the International Bureau before the expiry of 18 months from the date on which the International Bureau sent the notification of the limitation to the Office.

The Office must state whether the declaration affects all the goods and services that were the subject of the limitation or only some of them. In that latter case, the Office must provide a clear indication of those goods and services that are affected or those that are **NOT** affected. Where all the goods or services included in a given class are concerned, the indication should read "all goods (or all services) in class X".
