MODEL FORM 15 (MF15): DECLARATION THAT THE RECORDING OF A GIVEN LICENSE HAS NO EFFECT

Rule 20 bis(5) of the Regulations

Use this form when the International Bureau has notified the Office of the recording of a license under Rule 20*bis* and the Office wishes to declare that this recording has no effect in its territory.

The declaration must be sent to the International Bureau before the expiry of 18 months from the date on which the International Bureau sent the notification of the recording of the license to the Office.

The Office must specify whether the declaration affects all the goods and services that were the subject of the recording of the license or only some of them. In that latter case, the Office must provide a clear indication of those goods and services that are affected or those that are **NOT** affected. Where all the goods or services included in a given class are concerned, the indication should read "all goods (or all services) in class X".
