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PROTOCOL RELATING TO THE MADRID AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL REGISTRATION OF MARKS

Individual Fees under Article 8(7): Finland

(This notice replaces the English version of information notice No. 1/2002 which contained an error; the French version was correct.)

1. Finland has made a declaration under Article 8(7) of the Madrid Protocol the effect of which is to change the individual fee payable when Finland is designated under the Protocol either in an international application or in a designation subsequent to international registration, or in respect of renewal of an international registration in which Finland has been designated.
2. In accordance with Rule 35(2)(b) of the Common Regulations under the Madrid Agreement and Protocol, the Director General has, after consultation with the Office of Finland, established the following new amounts, in Swiss francs, of the said individual fee:

Designation fee (in the international application or in a subsequent designation):	CHF
– for three classes of goods or services where the mark is a collective mark	236 340
– for each additional class	88
Renewal:	CHF
– for three classes of goods or services where the mark is a collective mark	266 384
– for each additional class	140

3. The changes mentioned in the previous paragraphs will take effect on February 1, 2002. Therefore, these fees will be payable respectively where Finland

(a) is designated in an international application which is received, or is deemed to have been received under Rule 11(1)(c), by the Office of origin or after that date, or

(b) is the subject of a subsequent designation which is received by the Office of origin or another interested Office or after that date, or is filed direct with the International Bureau or after that date, or

(c) has been designated in an international registration which is renewed on or after that date.
