

Madrid Protocol Concerning the International Registration of Marks

Change in the Amounts of the Individual Fee: Norway

1. The Government of Norway has notified to the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) a declaration modifying the amounts of the individual fee payable with respect to Norway under Article 8(7) of the Madrid Protocol.
2. As from March 1, 2024, the amounts of the individual fee payable in respect of Norway will be the following:

3. These new amounts will be payable where Norway

(a) is designated in an international application which is received by the Office of origin on or after March 1, 2024; or

(b) is the subject of a subsequent designation which is received by the Office of the Contracting Party of the holder or is filed directly with the International Bureau of WIPO on or after that date; or

(c) has been designated in an international registration which is renewed on or after that date.
