

Madrid Protocol Concerning the International Registration of Marks

Change in the Amounts of the Individual Fee: United Arab Emirates

1. In accordance with Rule 35(2)(d) of the Regulations under the Madrid Protocol, the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) has established new amounts, in Swiss francs, of the individual fee that is payable when the United Arab Emirates is designated in an international application, in a designation subsequent to an international registration and in respect of the renewal of an international registration in which the United Arab Emirates has been designated.
2. As from November 2, 2025, the amounts of the individual fee payable in respect of the United Arab Emirates will be the following:

Renewal	– for each class of goods or services	1,630	1,420

3. These new amounts will be payable where the United Arab Emirates
 - (a) is designated in an international application received by the Office of origin on or after November 2, 2025; or

(b) is the subject of a subsequent designation received by the Office of the Contracting Party of the holder or filed directly with the International Bureau of WIPO on or after that date; or

(c) has been designated in an international registration renewed on or after that date.
