

## Madrid Protocol Concerning the International Registration of Marks

### New declaration under Article 8(7) of the Madrid Protocol: Cuba

1. The Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) has received a declaration from the Government of Cuba modifying the amounts of the individual fee payable with respect to Cuba under Article 8(7) of the Madrid Protocol. The new amounts of the individual fee indicated in that declaration have been expressed in United States dollars, in accordance with Rule 35(2)(a) of the Regulations under the Madrid Protocol.
2. While the new declaration will enter into force on December 19, 2025, the amounts of the individual fee in Swiss francs, established by the Director General of WIPO on the basis of the official exchange rate of the United Nations, will remain the same.
3. It is recalled that those amounts are the following:
