

Madrid Protocol Concerning the International Registration of Marks

Change in the Amounts of the Individual Fee: Israel

1. In accordance with Rule 35(2)(c) of the Regulations under the Madrid Protocol, the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) has established, at the request of the Office of Israel, new amounts, in Swiss francs, of the individual fee that is payable when Israel is designated in an international application, in a designation subsequent to an international registration and in respect of the renewal of an international registration in which Israel has been designated

2. As from October 17, 2026, the amounts of the individual fee payable in respect of Israel will be the following:

Renewal	– for one class of goods or services	840	896

3. These new amounts will be payable where Israel

(a) is designated in an international application received by the Office of origin on or after October 17, 2026; or

(b) is the subject of a subsequent designation received by the Office of the Contracting Party of the holder or filed directly with the International Bureau of WIPO on or after that date;
or

(c) has been designated in an international registration renewed on or after that date.
