

Madrid Protocol Concerning the International Registration of Marks

Change in the Amounts of the Individual Fee: Canada

1. The Government of Canada has notified the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) of a declaration modifying the amounts of the individual fee payable in respect of Canada under Article 8(7) of the Madrid Protocol.
2. As from January 1, 2027, the amounts of the individual fee payable in respect of Canada will be the following:

Renewal	– for one class of goods or services	342	353

3. These new amounts will be payable where Canada
 - (a) is designated in an international application received by the Office of origin on or after January 1, 2027; or

(b) is the subject of a subsequent designation received by the Office of the Contracting Party of the holder or filed directly with the International Bureau of WIPO on or after that date;
or

(c) has been designated in an international registration renewed on or after that date.
