

Madrid Protocol Concerning the International Registration of Marks

Change in the Amounts of the Individual Fee: United Kingdom

1. The Government of the United Kingdom has notified the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) of a declaration modifying the amounts of the individual fee payable in respect of the United Kingdom under Article 8(7) of the Madrid Protocol.
2. As from April 1, 2026, the amounts of the individual fee payable in respect of the United Kingdom will be the following:

3. These new amounts will be payable where the United Kingdom
 - (a) is designated in an international application received by the Office of origin on or after April 1, 2026; or

(b) is the subject of a subsequent designation received by the Office of the Contracting Party of the holder or filed directly with the International Bureau of WIPO on or after that date; or

(c) has been designated in an international registration renewed on or after that date.
