## ANNEX 2 / ANNEXE 2

## COMMENTS BY THE INTERNATIONAL BUREAU

*Elements concerning defects in sequence listings and related tables*

1. *Item 1.14:* The proposal for <!ATTLIST annex-c-bis annex-c-tables (1 | 2) #REQUIRED > is intended to indicate the status of two checkboxes in Box No. III of Form PCT/ISA/237. While it is hard to imagine a situation where both would be checked, in principle they are independent and should be represented by separate attributes, such as:

2. *Items 1.15 to 1.17:* The proposed attributes for <sequence-listing-material-type>, <sequence-listing-material-format> and <sequence-listing-filing-time> relate to sets of checkboxes concerning the basis of the search or written opinion (item 1 of Box No. I of the international search report; item 2 of Box No. I of the written opinion of the ISA; also equivalents in Forms 408 and 409). Again, these boxes in each set are not mutually exclusive—in the second and third sets it will be very unusual to have more than one box checked, but there are cases where it is possible. Consequently the status attributes relating to the boxes should be independent, for example:

3. Circular C. PCT 1074/C. SCIT 2624, dated April 24, 2006, proposes the deletion of Annex C-bis and significant restructuring of Annex C and other parts of the Administrative Instructions. If this comes into force, it will be necessary to review the parts of the Forms relating to sequence listings and the related DTD elements to determine whether they are still appropriate.

4. Consideration might also be given to extending element <material-of-sequence-list> to permit an explanation of any unusual entries in these elements (for example multiple “yes” answers in <sequence-listing-filing-time>), rather than relying only on the <additional-info> in <sequence-list-basis>, for example:

5. *Item 6:* While this proposal may solve the specific Swiss problem, it does not address the wider issue of a lack of provision for INID code 23. The code is very general and means “Other date(s), including date of filing complete specification following provisional specification and date of exhibition”. Provision should be made for any other dates, for

example as shown below. Also, it may be desirable to allow an attribute in the <date-application-partially-withdrawn> element proposed in the PFC to give other information, such as a reason or legal basis, as also shown below.

6. *Item 14:* The proposal itself is acceptable. It is observed, however, that appears to be a further defect in the model: since element <citation> can be non-patent literature as well as patent documents, there may not be an associated filing date. Consequently that element ought to be optional. Furthermore, the publication date of the citation may be the relevant matter, in which case it may be appropriate to include that as an optional element.

*Other issues*

7. While assessing the impact of the PFC, it was observed that some of the existing elements do not seem to cover all of the options required to create international search reports and written opinions in all cases. Furthermore, there is no provision made for an XML equivalent of Form PCT/ISA/203 (Declaration of Non-Establishment of International Search Report). Additional proposals may be required to correct these defects.

## COMMENTS BY THE JAPAN PATENT OFFICE

JP essentially agrees with IB's comments on PCT/EF/PFC 06/001. With regard to the comments #1, #2, #4 and #6, we would like to make some additional changes.

#1. JP agrees with IB's comment #1. JP also thinks the element for annex-c should be changed to the following:

*Elements concerning defects in sequence listings and related tables*

1. *Item 1.14:* agreed

EPO: We believe that these boxes will probably be mutually exclusive but have no objection to the IB suggestion since we are not yet in production with ISA forms.

2. *Items 1.15 to 1.17:*

EPO: as above - agreed.

4. We prefer to leave this as is and check on practice.

5. INID 23: We prefer to leave this as is; this is a difficult area since there may be many dates which are office specific and would probably be handled by the addition of the two letter country code.

6. *Item 14. <citations-explanations>*

EPO: Filing date - optional - agreed.

*Other issues*

7. While assessing the impact of the PFC, it was observed that some of the existing elements do not seem to cover all of the options required to create international search reports and written opinions in all cases.

EPO: We need to know what these are and are examining IB notes on this.

Furthermore, there is no provision made for an XML equivalent of Form PCT/ISA/203 . . .

EPO: There are many, many PCT forms not covered by XML - this is a matter for the IB, the initial work concerned only the ISR and the Written Opinion - with the emphasis on the ISR as the “main” form used by ISAs.
