## **Comments by the European Patent Office**

The EPO agrees with the proposed PCT/EF/PFC 09/002.

However the **EPO disagrees with the proposed PFR ST.36/2009/004**, which contrary to the PFC also affects elements of the model DTD, namely *bibliographic-data*. The proposed changes do not appear to be in line with the current handling of search-report information and should be put in perspective of the tagging of the Supplementary International Search Report. The EPO hereby submits a revised version of a <u>document</u> already provided to the TF Leader and the IB/PCT. Said document analyzes the impact of the Supplementary International Search Report and suggests some implementations. It could serve as a basis for a discussion concerning the tagging of the Supplementary International Search Report.

### **Comment by the European Patent Office**

## 1. **PFR ST.36 2009/004**:

The EPO formulated some suggestions on pages 18-19 of the attached document (<a href="https://www3.wipo.int/confluence/download/attachments/3440723/SISR-20090330.pdf?version=1">https://www3.wipo.int/confluence/download/attachments/3440723/SISR-20090330.pdf?version=1</a>). The suggestion is based on the fact that Supplementary International Search Report will reuse the search-report-data structure with a specific value of the attribute srep-type, e,g. "sisr". Please find a summary hereunder:

Item 1: Modification of bibliographic-data element to add Supplementary search information.

The EPO suggests that the **bibliographic-data is not modified** for this purpose as this information is recorded in the search-report area.

## Item 2: Add element supplementary-search-report-info

PFR implementation:

new | corrected | not-established ) #REQUIRED >
```

Suggested implementation:

The attribute sis-report-status is believed to be covered by search-report-data/@status.

date-search-completed and date-search-report-mailed are currently found in srep-for-pub/srep-admin, srep-info/srep-info-admin and bibliographic-data/references-cited. received-at-ib although part of the ICE is not currently in the model DTD. If felt necessary, received (which is in the model DTD) could be added as a child to srep-for-pub/srep-admin. Since other offices may outsource their search work, the EPO suggests to keep the tag generic.

Hence, the suggested implementation for item 2 is

```

Alternatively srep-info-admin could be modified or both structure could be modified.

## Item 3: Add element supplementary-search-request-info

PFR Implementation:

Information about the request is currently available in srep-request-date and srep-requestnumber under srep-info, the EPO suggest to gather all information under a new tag sreprequest:

Although in production with the search report, those tags are not used by the EPO which therefore does not need backwards compatibility: The EPO therefore **favours the first implementation (without backwards compatibility) for reasons of conciseness**.

#### Item 4: Add element supplementary-search-info

PFR implementation:

isa is covered by srep-info/srep-info-admin/srep-office and/or srep-for-pub/srep-admin/srep-office.

The other two items are covered by items 2 and 3.

Hence the EPO suggests to cancel item 4.

### New item 5: Update references-cited to enable sourcing the citations in a document

In the context of File Inspection and Register data, it is of importance to determine at which stage and/or who introduced a reference in the file.

Suggested implementation:

Alternative references-cited and its cardinality is not modified and the attributes cited-in and office are added to the element citation.

## **Comment by the International Bureau**

Following the comments received to date regarding this proposal and the related PFR ST.36/09/004, the International Bureau has the following comments and suggestions:

- following the second comment from EPO, that the group consider whether this 'processing status information' would be better placed outside the wo-bibliographic-data XML structure and retained inside the XML for the International Application Status Report (IASR). This would leave the bibliographic-data and wo-bibliographic data elements unchanged.
