

Hague Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Industrial Designs

Change in the amounts of the individual designation fee: Russian Federation

1. In accordance with Rule 28(2)(d) of the Common Regulations Under the 1999 Act and the 1960 Act of the Hague Agreement, the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) has established the following new amounts, in Swiss francs, of the individual designation fee which must be paid in connection with an international application in which the Russian Federation is designated, and in connection with the renewal of an international registration designating the Russian Federation:

* The Russian Federation has made a declaration under Article 13(1) of the 1999 Act of the Hague Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Industrial Designs whereby, in accordance with its law, industrial designs that are the subject of the same international application shall meet the requirement of the unity of a single creative concept.
