

Madrid Protocol Concerning the International Registration of Marks

Amounts of the Fees Relating to Requests to Be Filed Directly Before the Office of Colombia under the Madrid Protocol

1. The Government of Colombia has informed the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) of the amounts of the fees relating to requests to be filed directly before the Office of Colombia under the Protocol Relating to the Madrid Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Marks (the Madrid Protocol) and has requested that this information be made available to users of the Madrid system.

2. The following amounts of the aforementioned fees, which are expressed in the currency used by the Office of Colombia, namely, Colombian pesos, shall be paid directly to the said Office:

ITEMS	Amounts <i>(in Colombian pesos)</i>
– certification and transmission to the International Bureau of WIPO of an international application for which the Office of Colombia is the Office of origin (Articles 3 and 8(1) of the Madrid Protocol)	60,000
– request for transformation of an international registration designating Colombia into a national application, where protection has not yet been finally granted in Colombia (Article 9 <i>quinquies</i> of the Madrid Protocol)	375,000
– request for transformation of an international registration designating Colombia into a national application, where protection has been finally granted in Colombia (Article 9 <i>quinquies</i> of the Madrid Protocol)	100,000
– request that the Office of Colombia take note in its register of an international registration (replacement under Article 4 <i>bis</i> (2) of the Madrid Protocol)	20,000

ITEMS	Amounts <i>(in Colombian pesos)</i>
– request for the division of an international registration in which Colombia has been designated, where protection has not yet been finally granted in Colombia (Article 4(1)(a) of the Madrid Protocol)	700,000
– request for the division of an international registration in which Colombia has been designated, where protection has been finally granted in Colombia (Article 4(1)(a) of the Madrid Protocol)	300,000

3. The Government of Colombia has also informed the Director General of WIPO that the abovementioned amounts have been in effect since January 1, 2013.
