

## Madrid Protocol Concerning the International Registration of Marks

### Change in the Amounts of the Individual Fee: African Intellectual Property Organization (OAPI)

1. In accordance with Rule 35(2)(c) of the Common Regulations under the Madrid Agreement and Protocol, the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) has, at the request of the African Intellectual Property Organization (OAPI), established the following new amounts, in Swiss francs, of the individual fee that is payable when OAPI is designated in an international application, in a designation subsequent to an international registration and in respect of the renewal of an international registration in which OAPI has been designated:

ITEMS		Amounts <i>(in Swiss francs)</i>
Application or Subsequent Designation	– for three classes of goods or services	704
	– for each additional class	144
Renewal	– for one class of goods or services	880
	– for each additional class	176
	<i>Where payment is received within the period of grace:</i> – additional amount, independent of the number of classes	229

2. This change shall have effect on September 9, 2018. Therefore, these amounts will be payable where OAPI

- (a) is designated in an international application which is received by the Office of origin on or after that date; or

(b) is the subject of a subsequent designation which is received by the Office of the Contracting Party of the holder on or after that date, or is filed directly with the International Bureau of WIPO on or after that date; or

(c) has been designated in an international registration which is renewed on or after that date.
